Our monthly LHCS PTA meeting will be held in the Upper Campus Media

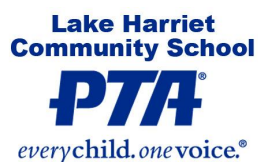

Learn About Ways to Get Involved with PTA and Site Council

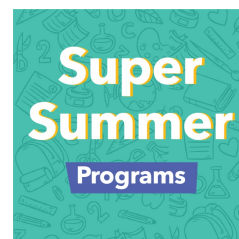
