The volunteer background check process is now open

for the school year! **All direct volunteers should visit [this page](#)** of the website to fill out the Background Check Request form and follow the steps to complete their check.

Some key items to note:

- Per MPS policy, background checks are required for any volunteer who will be working in an unsupervised role with students.
- Background checks are completed online to protect volunteer's private information.
- There is no cost to the volunteer or school to run a background check. *We do ask that you only complete background checks for volunteers who are required to have one because there is a cost to the district to run each check.*
- Background check results are valid for two years.
