History Day Tasks, Due Dates, and Descriptions

Due on Monday, November 21, 2011	Task: History Day Browse Notes 1 (5 points)
Description: Students will use the computer lab to identify and evaluate ten possible topics for research and will identify five keywords for each that will help in their research.	
Due on Tuesday, November 22, 2011	Task: History Day Browse Notes 2 (5 points)
Description: Students will use the computer lab to identify and evaluate ten possible topics for research and will identify five keywords for each that will help in their research.	
Due on Friday, December 2, 2011	Task: Parent Form (5 points)
Description: Students and parents will confirm their understanding of the History Day process.	
Due on Friday, December 9, 2011	Task: HD #1 (5 points)
Description: Students will identify questions to address in their research and identify keywords that will help in their research.	
Due on Friday, December 16, 2011	Task: HD #2: Secondary Sources (5 points)
Students will identify the secondary sources they will use in their research.	
Due on Thursday, December 22, 2011	Task: HD #3: Refining your Topic (5 points)
Description: Students will refine their research topic from a general area of interest to a more focused and manageable research topic.	
Due on Monday, January 9, 2011	Task: Public Library Book Due (5 points)
Description: Students will bring to class at least two books on their topic from a Hennepin County Public Library.	
Due on Wednesday, January 11, 2012	Task: HD #4: Primary Sources (5 points)
Description: Students will identify the primary sources they will use in their research.	
Due on Thursday, January 12, 2012	Task: Five Pages of Google Docs Notes (10 points)
Students will turn in five pages of notes they've created in Google Docs for their research.	
Due on Tuesday, January 17, 2012	Task: Topic/Group Choice (5 points)
Description: Each student must turn in a sheet that identifies their final topic and group choices. This sheet must have a parent's signature.	
Due on Friday, January 20, 2012	Task: Q&A Assignment and Bibliography (10 Points)
Description: Each student must complete a Q & A assignment that demonstrates their understanding of their topic. Part of the assignment is 6-item annotated bibliography.	
Due Wednesday, February 1, 2012	Task: Thesis Statement (10 Points)
Description: This statement is the heart of the History Day project. It will be about 1-3 sentences long and will answer the student's central research questions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Why is my topic important? ◆ What does my topic have to do with "Exploration, Encounter, Exchange in History?" ◆ What assertion am I trying to support with my project? 	
Due on Wednesday, February 8, 2012	Task: Project Description (10 Points)
Description: Each student must complete a project description for their topic, thesis, evidence that will serve as the content for their project.	
Due Tuesday, February 21, 2012	Task: Process Paper Draft and Annotated Bibliography Draft (15 points)
Description: Students describe their experiences with the research process and describe how found information and how their research focus changed over time. The description is to be three paragraphs long and no more than 500 words. The annotated bibliography must include at least ten secondary sources and five primary sources.
