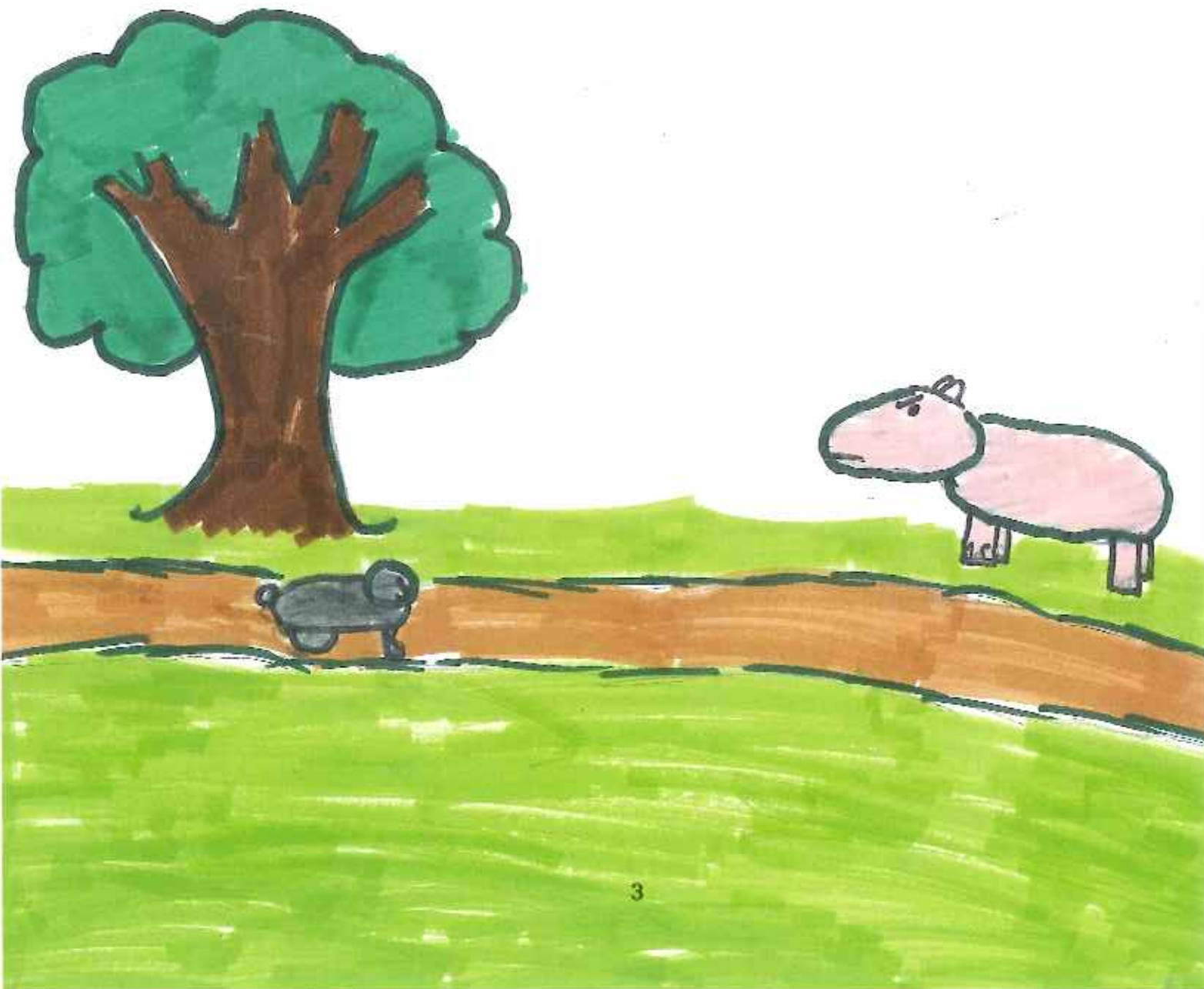
Once there was a bunny
named Toby.



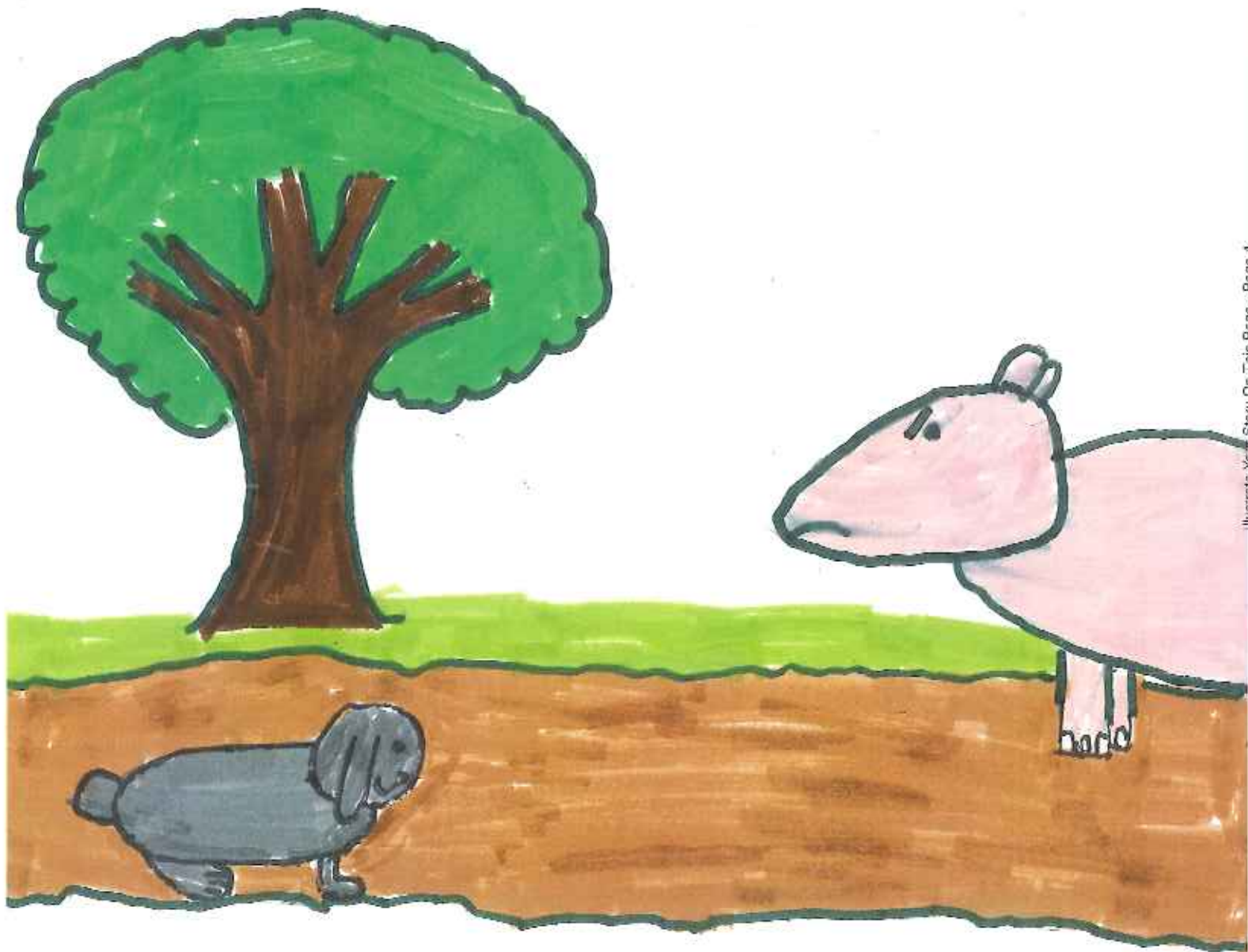
He was walking along

the path!

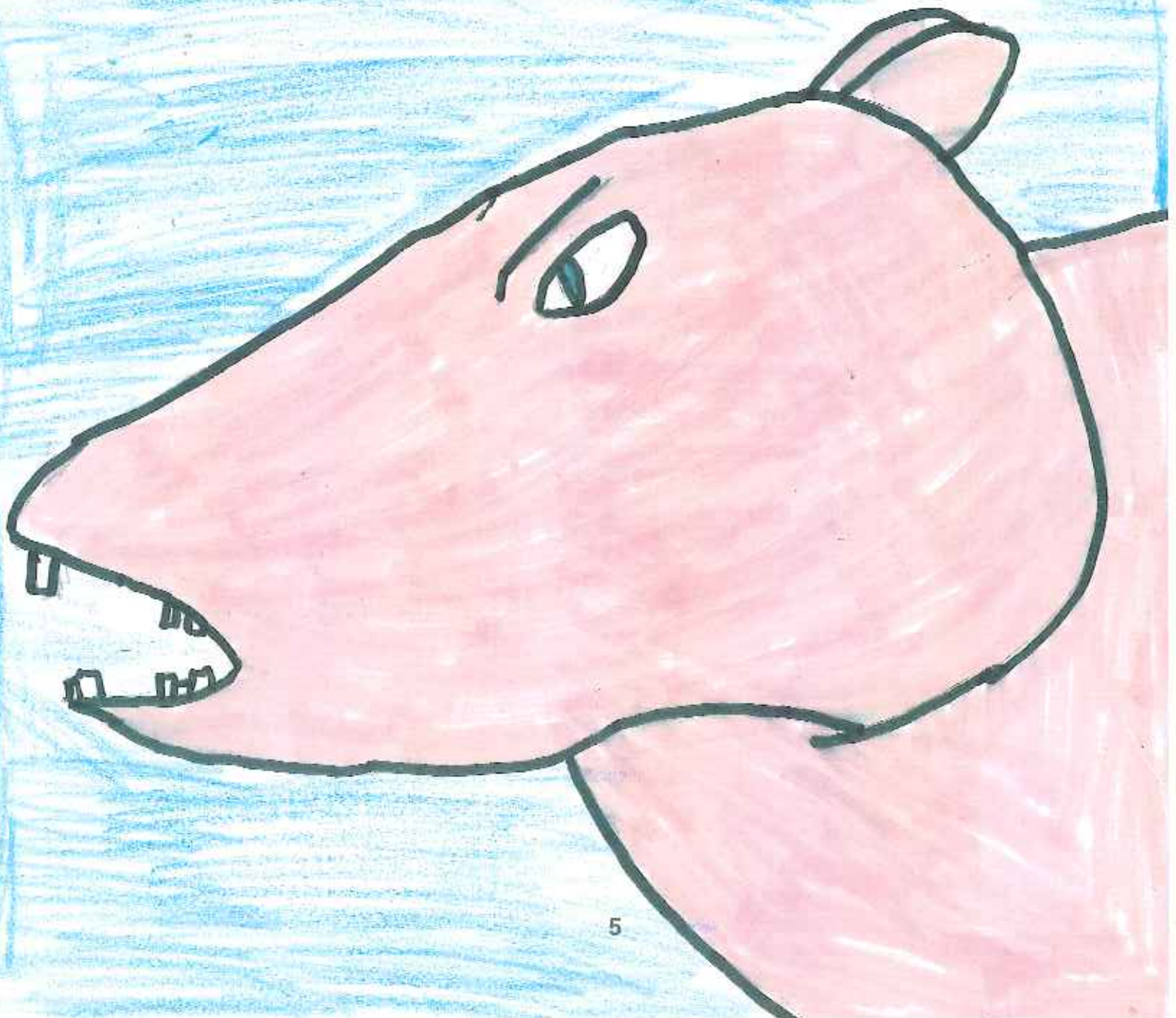


"Move!" The hippo

Growled the angry hippo.

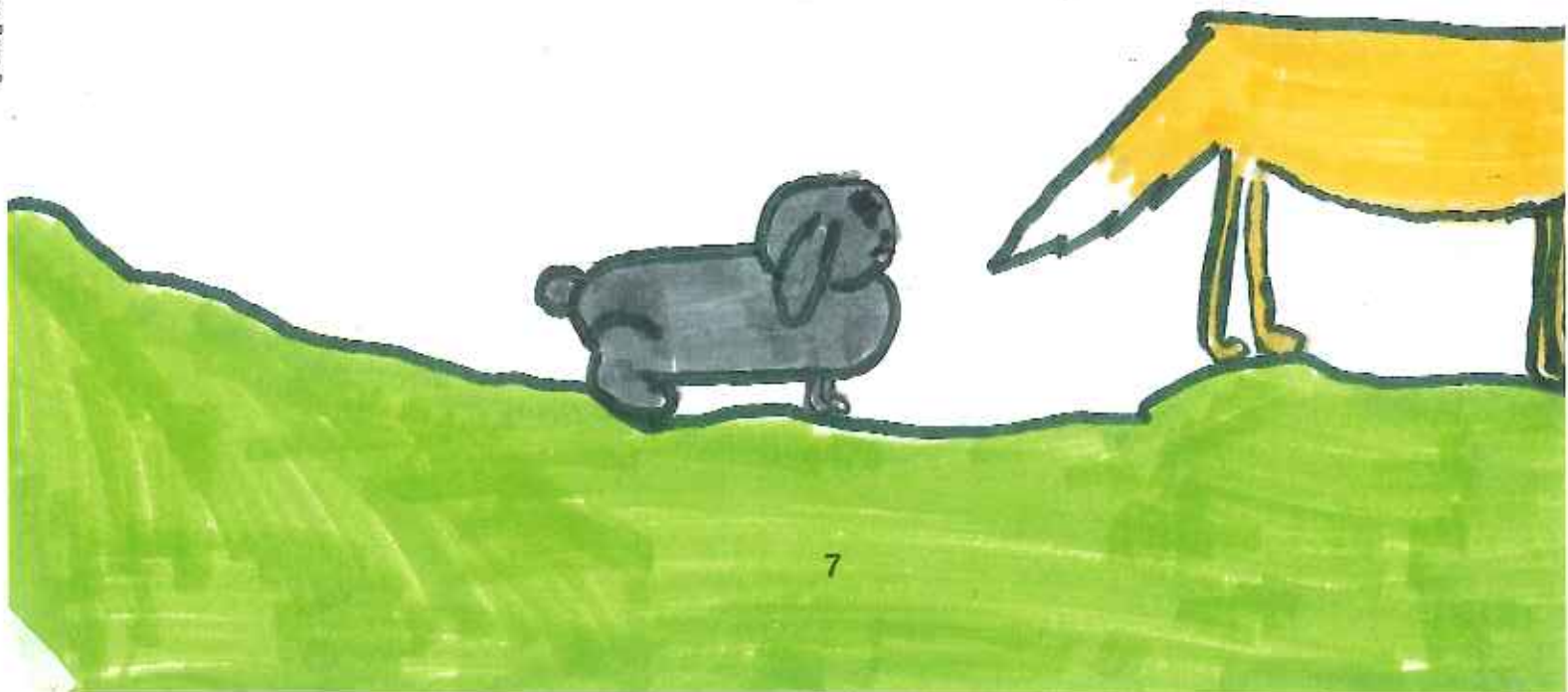

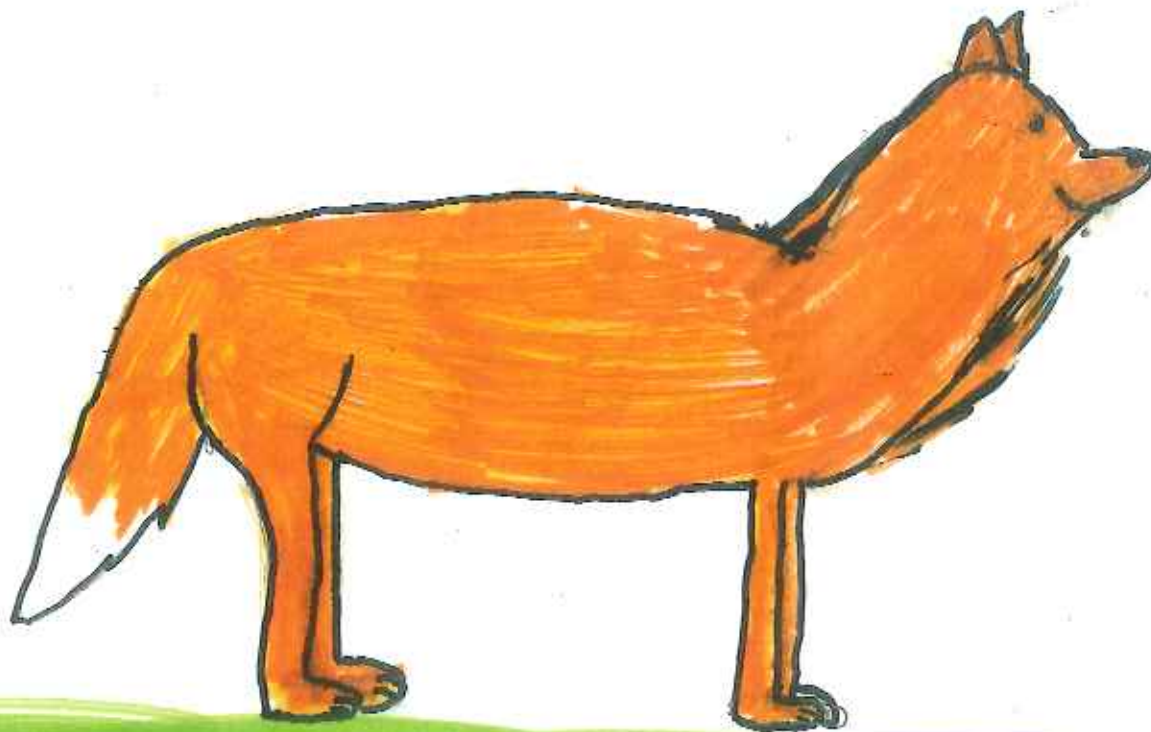
"Fine!" Toby yelled,

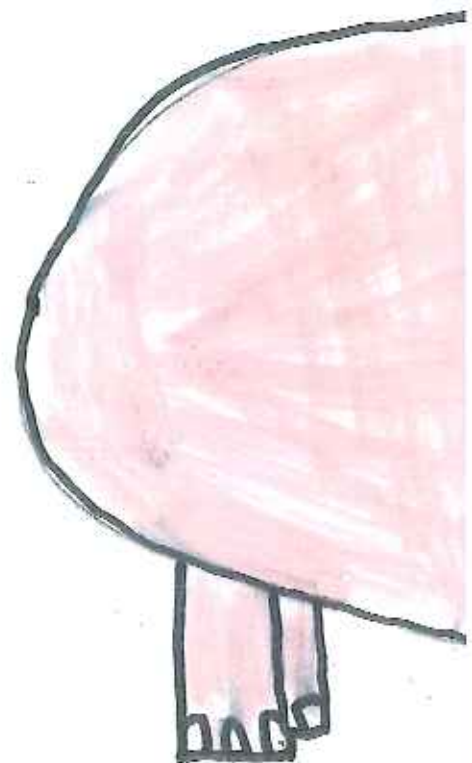
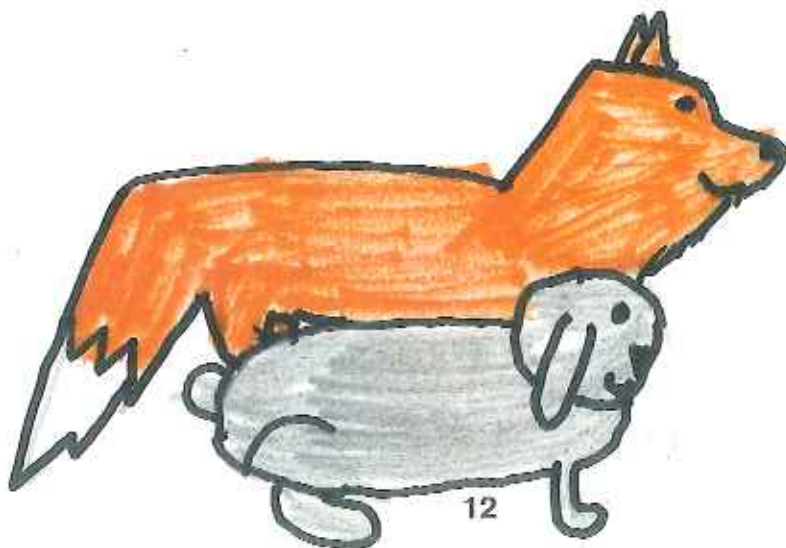

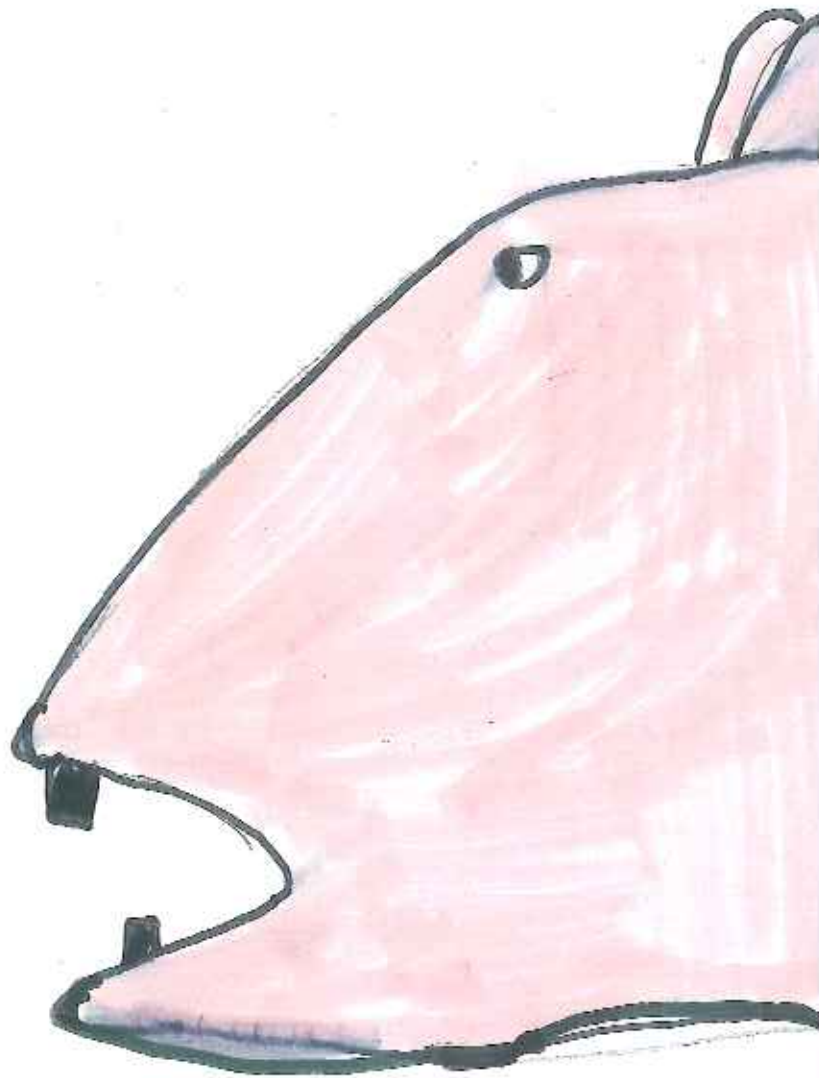
"Hi there! How are you guys doing today?" Asked Annie.
