

Eidem Homestead Field Trip!

As an enhancement to our *Time: Now & Then* social studies unit during the month of October, the kindergarteners will visit Eidem Homestead in Brooklyn Park!

What is Eidem Homestead?

Eidem Homestead is a ten-acre living history farm that was restored to the period 1890 to 1910. Today, the farm is like a time machine, transporting you back to the turn of the 20th Century. Everybody had a job to do on the farm and students will experience what their role(s) would have been if they had lived during this time period. Children will tour the beautifully restored Victorian house, visit the barn, outbuildings and farm animals. They may smell the delicious apple cake baking in the kitchen, help pump water for the garden, and turn the handle on the wringer washing machine.

Due to the hands-on nature of this experience and limited space, the kindergarten rooms will be splitting into two groups and visiting the farm on two separate dates.
