Alex heard strange, creepy noises coming from the shadows under his bed. He could only imagine what was making them.



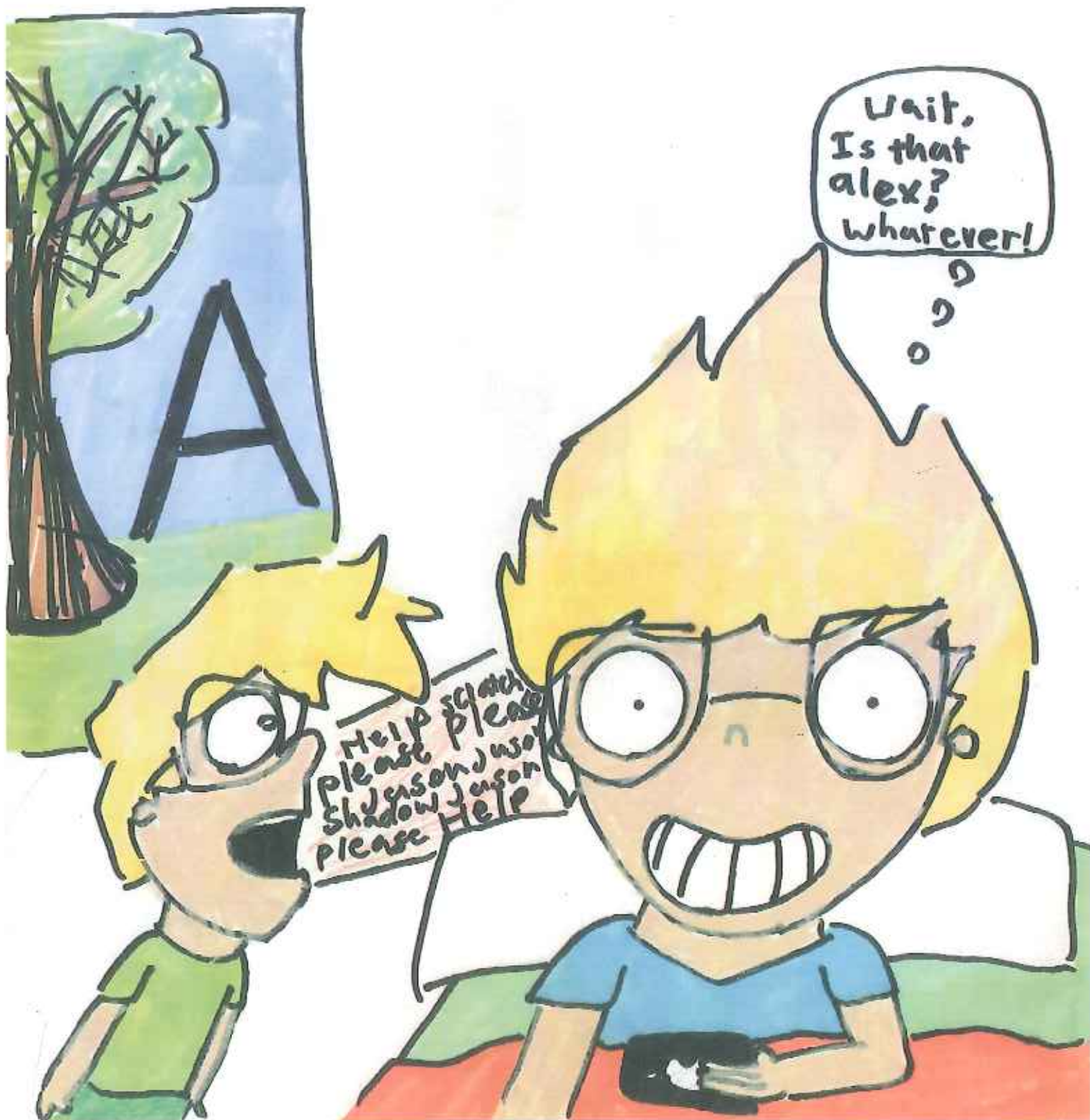
He thought it was best to leave it alone, for now.

No wait, aliens. Close enough. He went to Jason's room.



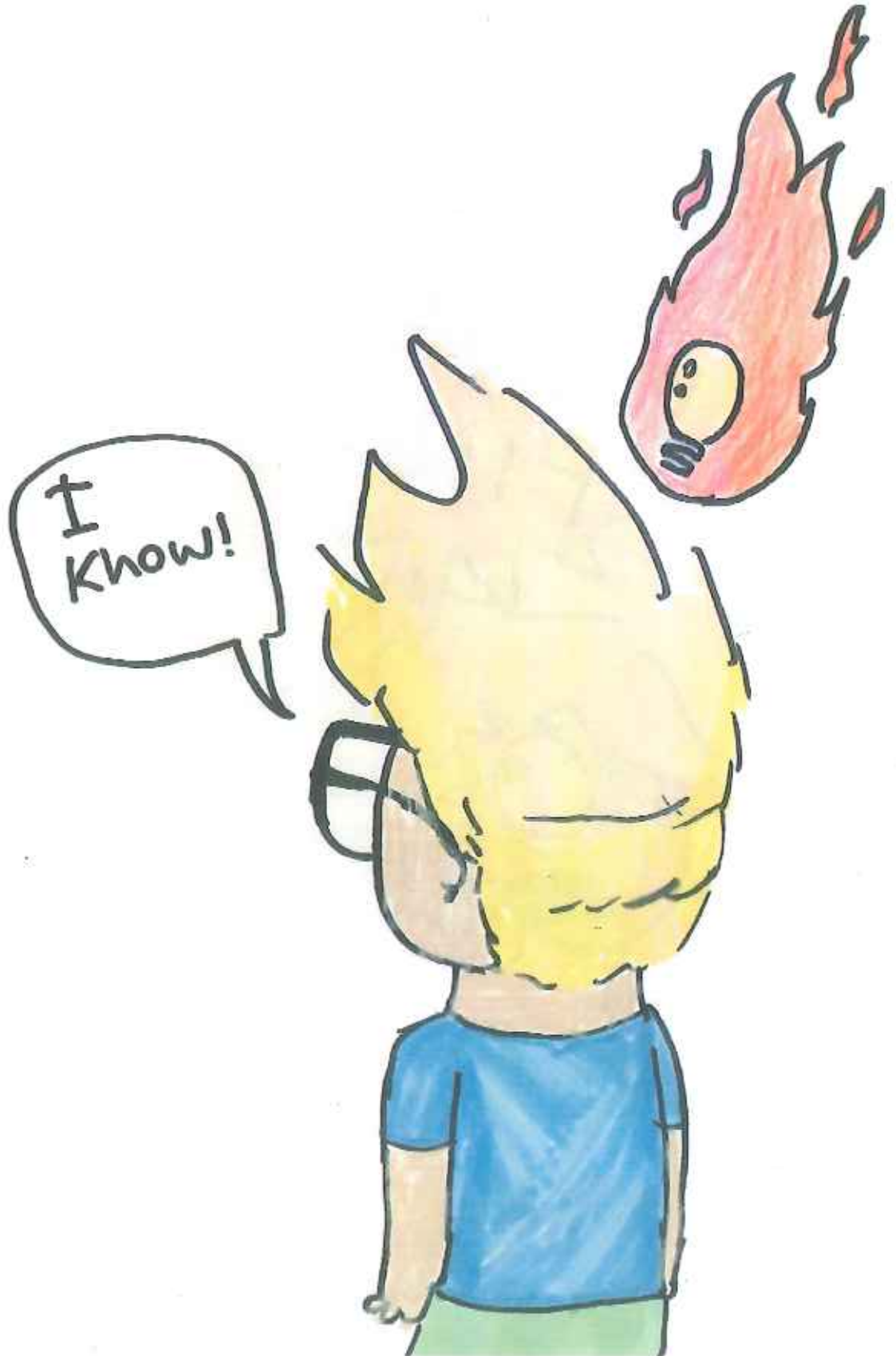
He started whining, but Jason didn't respond at first.



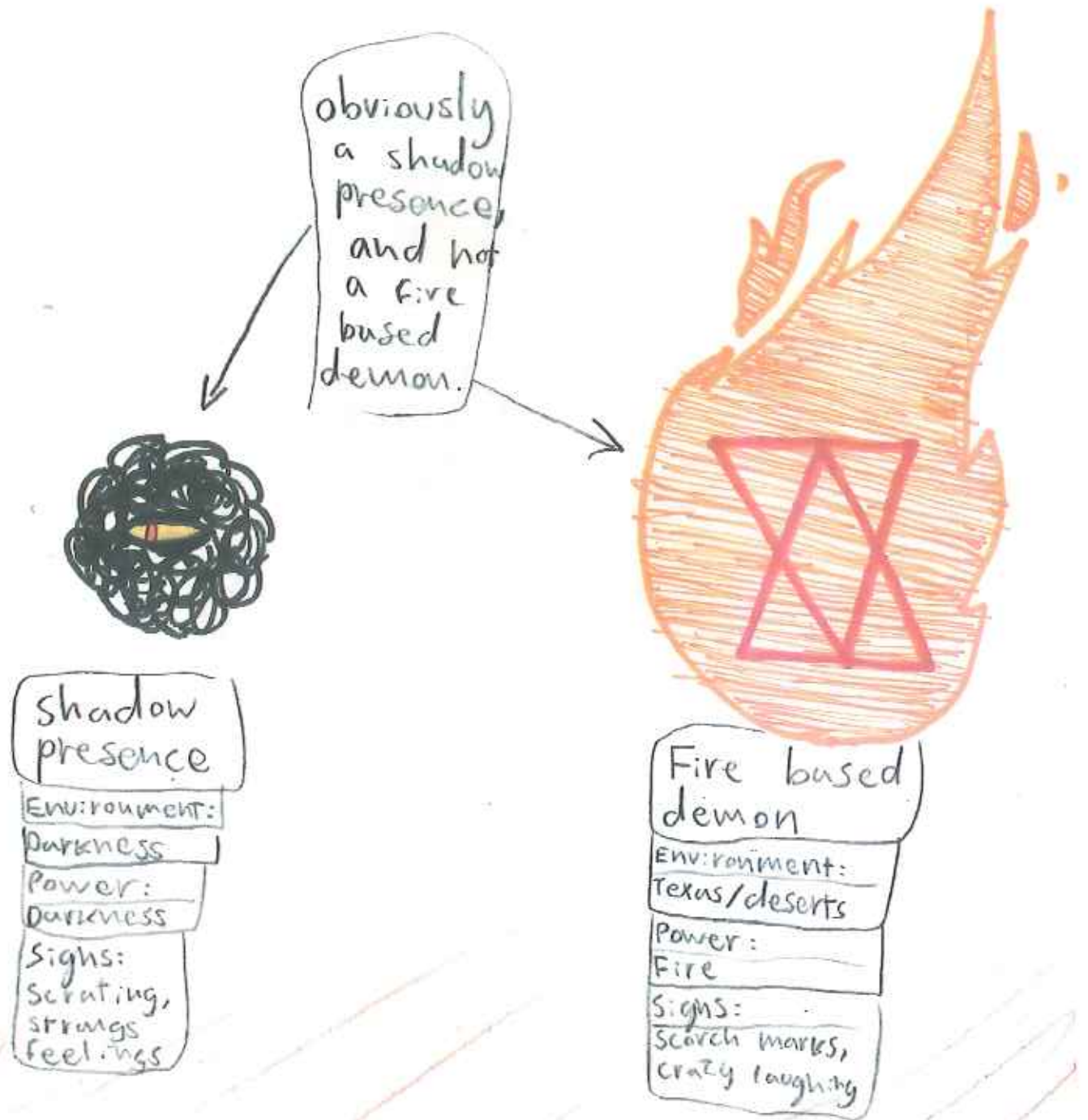
Eventually, Alex's voice got to Jason. It was so annoying that he decided to help Alex.



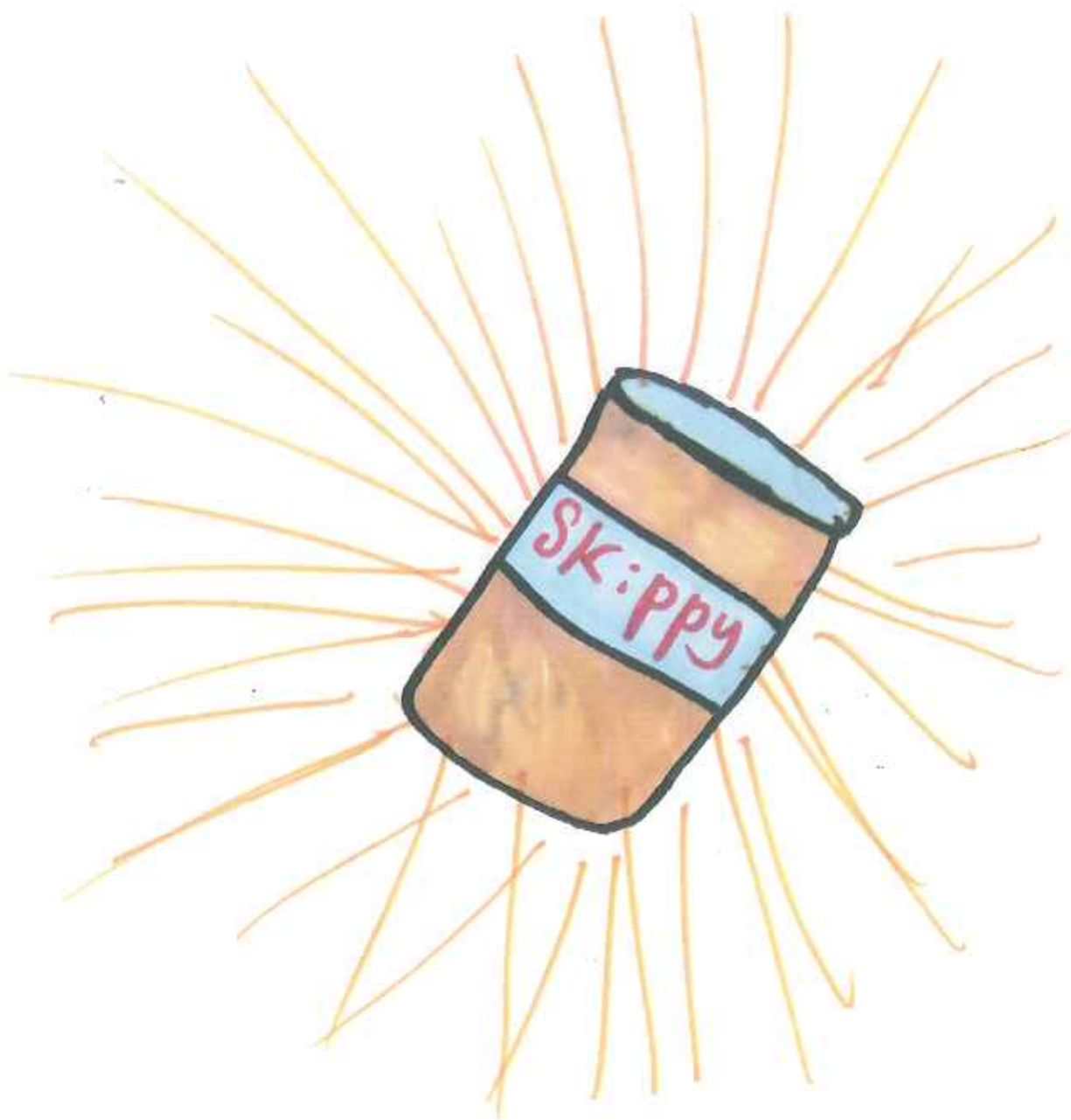
After listening to Alex's story, Jason knew what was under the bed.



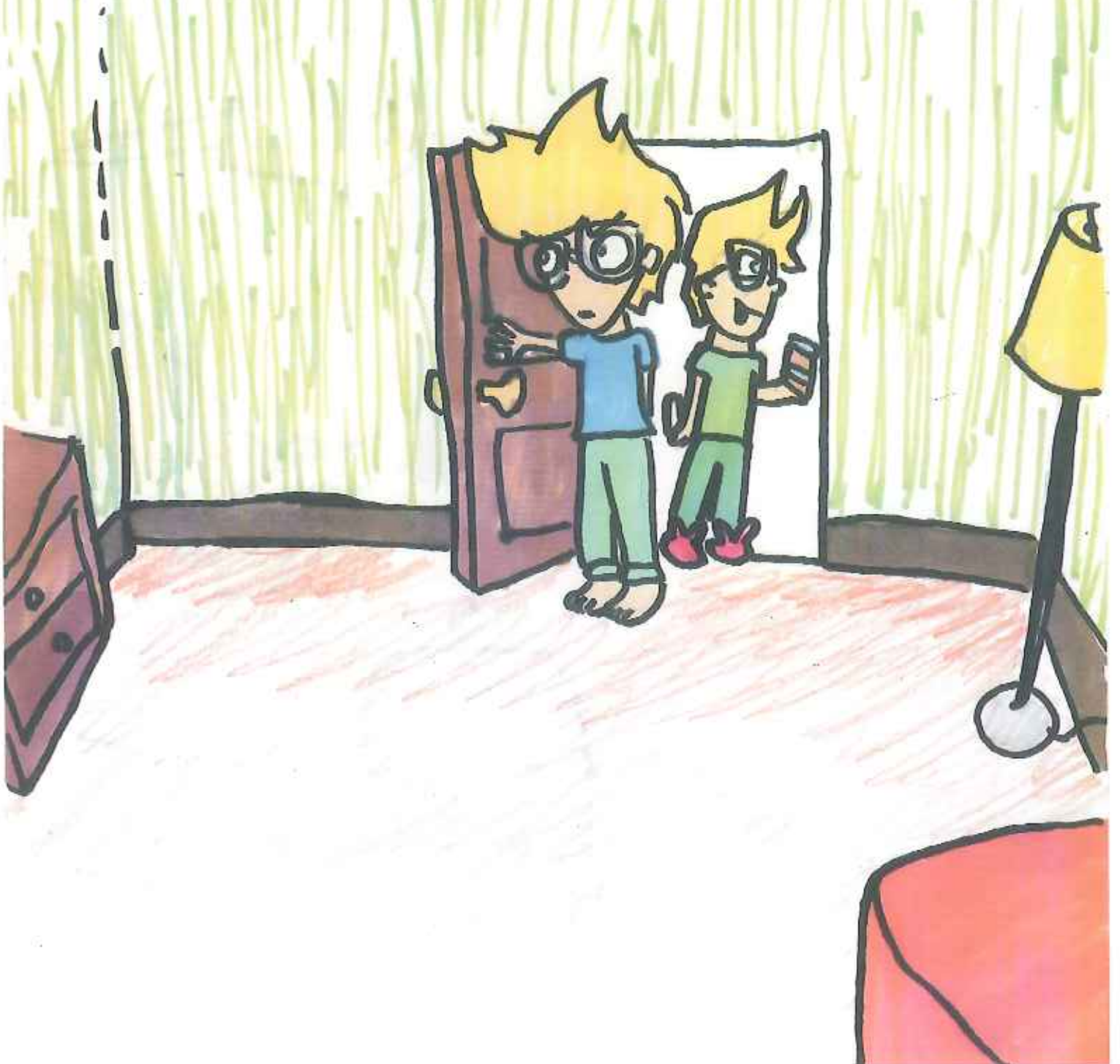
Jason explained that it wasn't a "Fire based demon," as Alex had thought. It was a shadow presence, which are easy to get rid of.



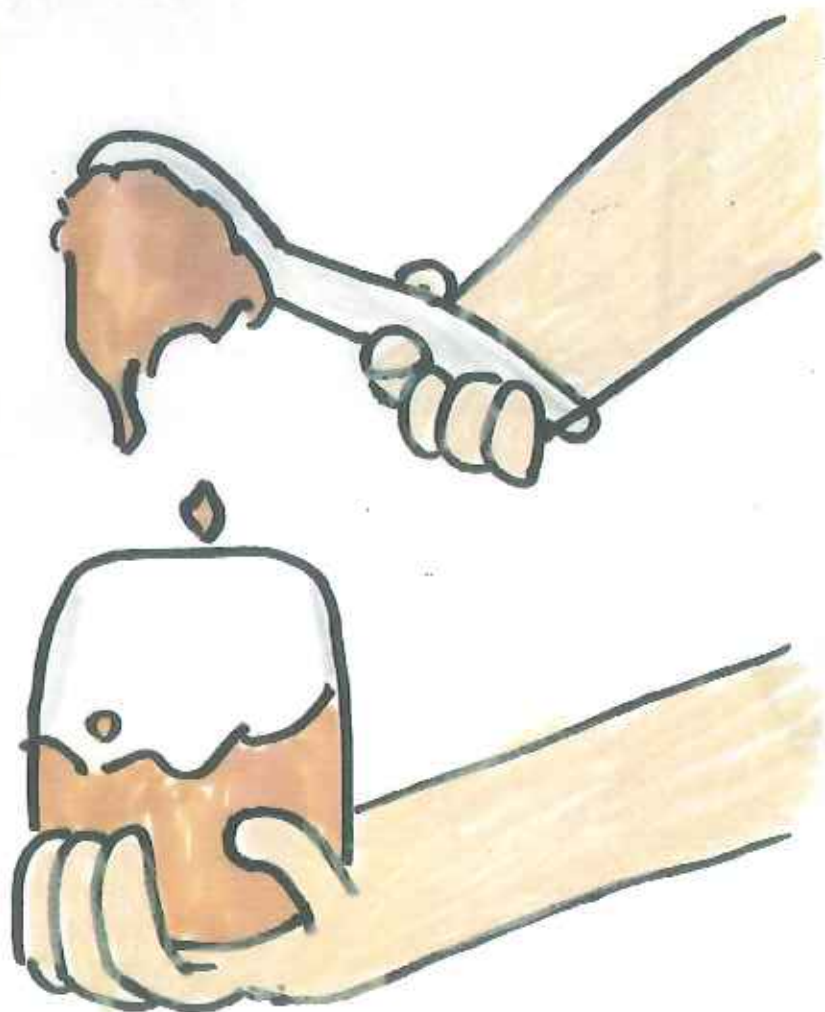
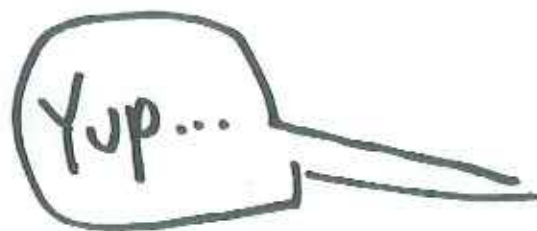
Step one: Make a trap. "Grab a jar, and peanut butter" Jason said. "They love peanut butter."



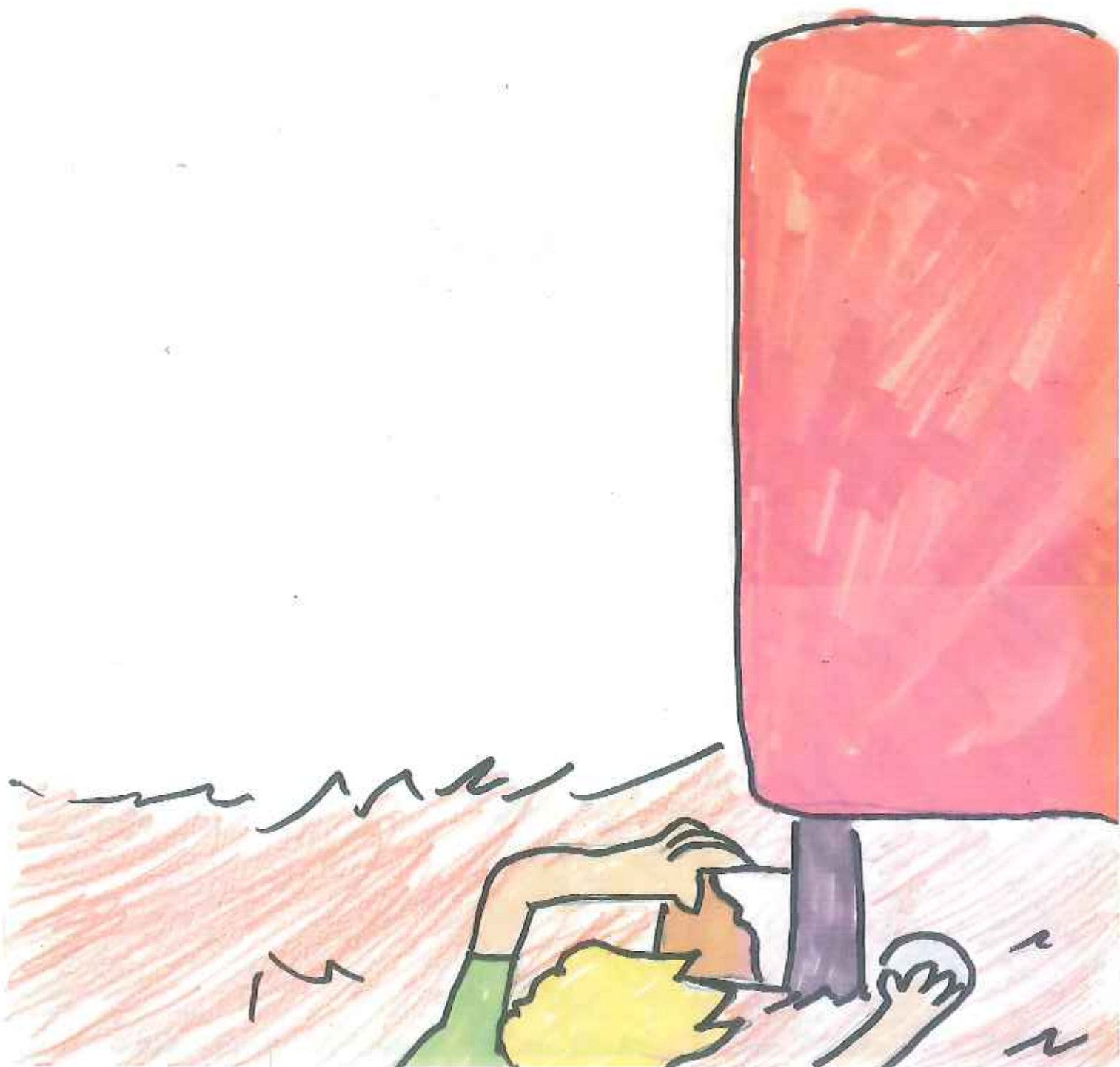
Step two: The two went to Alex's room. They set the 'Trap'
