- Robotics Teams meet 2 - 4 hours per week and participate in up to 2 weekend tournaments in January and 1 in February, depending on how teams advance. Meetings are held either before or after school, at LH Upper or at a parent's home if team is parent coached.
- The **MPLS District Robotics Tournament** will be held on **January 26, 2019**. An earlier LHCS Tournament is tentatively scheduled for January 12, 2019, depending on the total number of LHCS teams and available competitor slots at the District Tournament.
- Program **REQUIRES** development of a formal presentation **in addition to the robotics challenge**, based on research, team-work and meetings **outside of robotics meetings**; parents should expect to help coordinate their child's work on presentations. See the First Lego League website, firstlegoleague.org, for more information on the project requirement and robotics challenge.
- Program will begin in late September, exact start date and orientation briefing TBD. Team meetings will begin after orientation.
