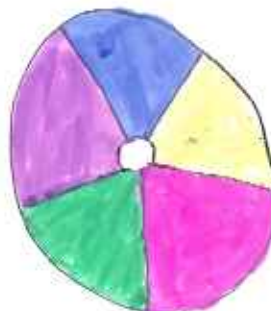

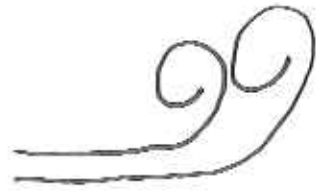

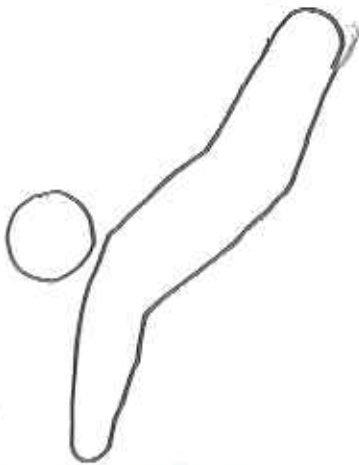


Ocean

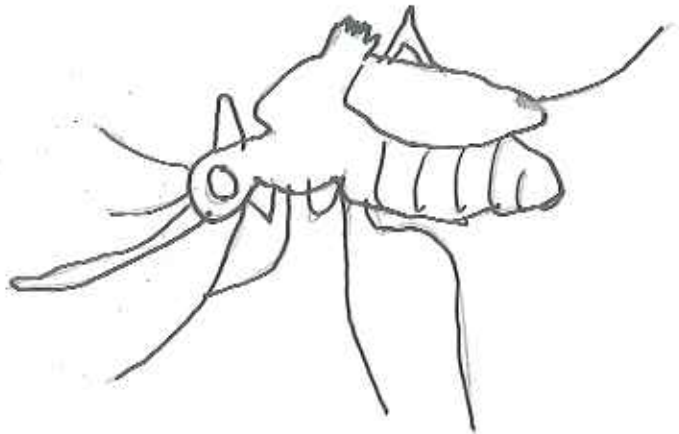


Pool

Pool Party

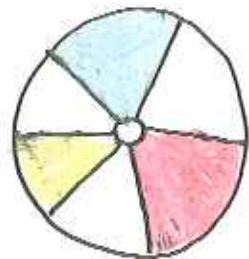
* Jump into the pool

And you will look like a devil's head



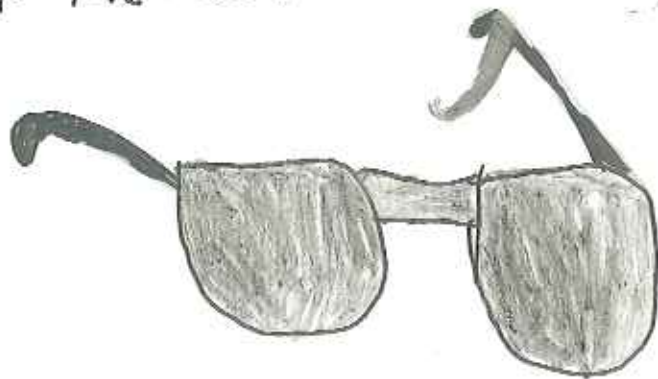
Barbecue

Picnic



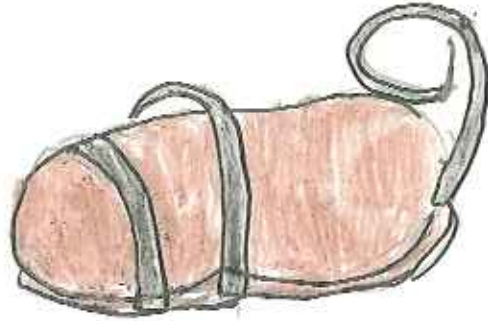
Sunglasses

Looks cool without them



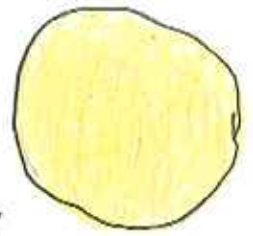
Shorts

Looks great on you too

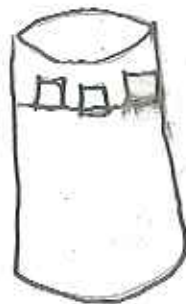


Sunshine

Comes up tomorrow

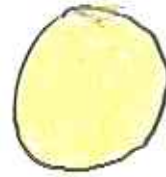
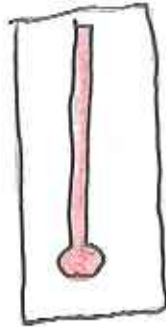


Water

Liquid



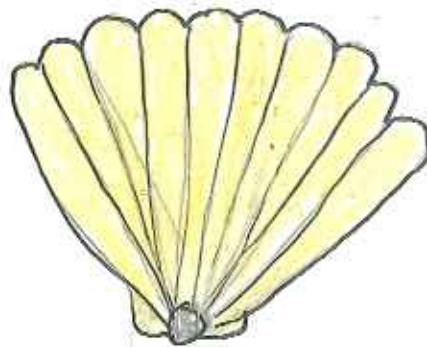
Humidness
